Looking for IT talent? Get a wage subsidy to hire a student Applications for the Winter 2019 Wage Subsidy for Student Work Integrated Program available until mid-November

A part of the Government of Canada's Student Work Integrated Learning Program, the talent division of ITAC is hard at work matching students with small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) to help them on the path to a bright career. Many ITAC members have already taken advantage of this opportunity to hire ICT students for work-terms; and due to the exceptionally positive experiences, have applied to the Program more than once (see testimonials [here](#)).

Applications for the 2019 winter semester (January to April) are now being accepted. The **deadline to apply is November 15, 2018**. One hundred thirty (130) wage subsidy spots are available and successful applicants will be notified the first week of December.

What does the Program offer?

The Career Ready Program provides up to 50 per cent (to a maximum of \$5,000) of a work term student's pay in wage subsidies to employers. Employers that hire students from underrepresented groups including women in STEM, Indigenous students, recent immigrants, persons with disabilities, and first-year students may also qualify for additional funding (up to 70 per cent or \$7,000).

What students qualify?

Current post-secondary students who are studying in the areas of [Business Technology Management](#) (BTM), Computer Science, Computer Systems Technology, Computer Engineering or alike programs qualify for the Career Ready program. We work closely with the work term department staff at the post-secondary institutions to help students and employers bridge the school-to-work transition.

Difficulty Finding a Student?

If you need to fill a position, you can post your job on the [Career Ready Job Portal](#). Your posting will be made available immediately to the co-op departments of all participating universities and colleges within your home province.

If your job posting is approved, students will be able to see your posting and apply for it – either directly to your organization’s job portal or through the Career Ready Job Portal.
