ITAC member and management consulting firm Korn Ferry tasked with searching for new ITAC President & CEO

For those members who did not have the opportunity to read ITAC's [New Year President's Report](#), Robert Watson stepped down as President and CEO of ITAC to pursue other opportunities late last year. We appreciate his many contributions and wish him great success in the future.

Until such a time that a new President and CEO is announced, ITAC's Vice President of Industry Development, Denise Shortt, has taken on the role of Acting President and CEO.

Executive Search

The Board Selection Committee (with oversight from the National Executive Committee) is currently working with Korn Ferry, a management consulting firm, to locate a new leader for the Association.

Korn Ferry, a respected ITAC member firm who is conducting the search on a pro-bono basis, has narrowed down an extensive list of highly qualified candidates and the interview process is well underway. Barring an unforeseen delay, it is the Board Selection Committee's intention that a new CEO will be selected by the next National Board Meeting, which will be held on February 27. Should the full National Board be in agreement, an offer will then be made. This would mean that a new leader should be in place in March.
