

Update on recent Public Sector Business Committee Meetings

The TECHNATION Government Relations and Policy team has been working closely with the Federal and National Public Sector Business Committees (PSBC) on a variety of initiatives. Below is an update on the most recent activities:

- On Monday, June 22, TECHNATION hosted its Federal Public Sector Business Committee meeting, which we expect to be the last before our summer break. The Committee welcomed **Paul Wagner, Interim Chief Technology Officer of the Government of Canada**, who presented on his new role and priorities over his term. We also welcomed **Guylaine Carriere, Director, Center of Expertise in Agile and Innovative Procurement at Shared Services Canada**, who spoke on agile procurement and the Centre of Excellence.
 - TECHNATION is in consistent engagement with SSC concerning agile procurement and we expect the Centre of Excellence will report back to the PSBC this Fall on their progress.
- On June 4, TECHNATION hosted its second National Public Sector Business Committee meeting. Members heard from representatives of four provinces and territories, in addition to written submissions from others, on their respective government's work on digital transformation and economic development. We look forward to continuing this work in the Fall.
